- 4) To create a family environment with quality cohesion and a firm understanding of discipline as a whole.
- 5) To develop the most competitive team(s) that we possibly can while maintaining a balance between development and winning for all those involved.
- 6) To work harder than, to learn more than, and to have much more fun than any other club in the nation and world.



Player Policies/Expectations

DO SOMETHING POSITIVE EVERY SINGLE DAY!!!

INITIAL ON EACH LINE!

1) I will show up, EVERYday. I understand that my attitude dictates my performance over the duration of my career. I will focus on bringing the best attitude I possibly can to the field and always seek to find the positive in my team mates and the situations I encounter. I will always come to practice and be 10-15 minutes early. If I can not make it to practice, I will always let my coaches know in advance so they know my situation. I am also aware that I am not allowed to miss more than 2 practices in any month unless cleared by my coach. _____ players initials

2) I will maintain a 3.0 GPA. I understand that MADE is not here to babysit me, but they are here to teach me how to maximize my abilities on and off the field. I understand that it is my responsibility to uphold my primary focus, which is my school work. I will prioritize my time, do my homework, and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA. If I cannot maintain a 3.0 GPA I will greatly hurt my team because I will be put on academic probation. I understand that on academic probation I am only allowed to come to one practice a week and I am not allowed to play in tournaments for one month, but I am still required to attend the tournaments.

Additionally, I understand the value of getting good grades in school and I will consistently strive to achieve the highest GPA that I possibly can. I will not accept simply “getting by” with a 3.0. I realize as a baseball player and young man that it is my responsibility to balance my time accordingly between school work and baseball, and I will not use school as an excuse to miss any of my obligations to the MADE Baseball Program. _____ players initials

3) I will carry the BODY LANGUAGE of Champion consistently and I will never pout or mope on the field. I realize that this is an EVERYday aspect of who we are as a program. This aspect of the game **can always be controlled**. Physical errors happen, sometimes by us and other times by a teammate. Either way they are frustrating, but I understand that the way in which I respond to these errors always determines my overall success. _____ players initials

4) I promise to play hard. Its that simple. There is never an excuse to play anything less than as hard as you possibly can, scratching and clawing, and doing what it takes in order to give your team the best possible chance you can to win. I understand that I should NOT EXPECT PLAYING TIME, BUT THAT I MUST EARN IT through my work ethic and my performance in all aspects of the game, on and off the field. Also, I will not assume that I will keep my spot on the club if I display a consistently bad attitude, work ethic, or lack of desire to be MADE. _____ players initials

5) Play smart. Physical errors happen and will always be part of the game no matter what level you play at. We will always try to minimize physical errors through repetition and practice. Mental errors will not be tolerated. _____ players initials

6) I understand that I must look good to play good. I will come to practice like I play for the Diamondbacks. I will keep my shoes clean, my pants washed, and I will maintain an overall professionalism towards my appearance EVERYday. I realize that sharp looking teams that look Big League can be very intimidating towards the opposition. I understand that it is very important that I take great care of my uniforms and gear, and that I look my best at all times. _____ players initials



7) I will respect my coaches and I will do what I am told. I understand that I have been chosen to be a part of the MADE Baseball program because the staff feels that I carry the potential to be a great player. I will take pride in the fact that I am a part of this program, I will behave myself, and I will listen to what my coaches instruct me to do at all times. players initials
